ARTICLE V: Executive Council

Section 7: The Archivist shall be the immediate past president and shall search for, collect, assemble and safeguard appropriate records, documents, papers, programs, and publications of the Association. Upon completion of a term in office, each officer and committee chairperson shall deliver into the custody of the Archivist all papers of potential historical value. The Archives shall reside in an appropriate library in the Carolinas. The Executive Council shall be empowered to make a location change if needed.

ARTICLE V: Executive Council

Section 7: The Archivist shall be the immediate past president of the association or a member of the association designated by the President if the immediate past president declines the role. There will be no set term for the Archivist if designated by the President. The Archivist shall search for, collect, assemble and safeguard appropriate records, documents, papers, programs, and publications of the Association. Upon completion of a term in office, each officer and committee chairperson shall deliver into the custody of the Archivist all papers of potential historical value. The Archives shall reside in an appropriate library in the Carolinas. The Executive Council shall be empowered to make a location change if needed.
